Regarding: Fresno Unified Climate/Culture and Social-Emotional Learning Survey Results

The purpose of this communication is to provide the Board requested information on the Climate/Culture and Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) survey results administered during Spring 2019/20. Student, parent, and staff surveys were completed in early March prior to school closures. Only students in grades 4 to 12 participate in the annual survey. 37,845 students completed the Climate/Culture and SEL student survey, 24,822 parents completed the Climate/Culture parent survey, and 4,714 staff completed the Climate/Culture staff survey. Sixty-nine percent of students reported feeling there is a teacher or some other adult at school who cares about them and 45% of students believe that students at their school care about each other, while 67% of staff reported feeling that students at their school site care about each other.

To further address the climate/culture of our district, a collaborative team of Equity and Access, African American Academic Acceleration, Goal 2, Communications, Prevention and Intervention, Special Education, and English Learner Services have begun a Student Voice Collaborative across various departments and student groups. The purpose of this collaborative is to involve students' in school-related issues and concerns toward improving the climate and culture of their school. This collaborative aims to ensure representation from various student groups, create alignment in efforts, and ensure all student groups have a voice and an opportunity to be heard.


As we begin the school year through distance learning, the need to increase community building and social emotional learning (SEL) opportunities for our students is heightened. Engaging intentionally in community building and SEL helps increase connectedness, belonging, engagement, empathy, and emotional literacy skills. The Department of Prevention & Intervention Climate and Culture Office partnered with classroom teachers to develop three weeks of K-12 community building and SEL lessons for teachers to utilize to foster the environments and skills necessary for learning. The Climate & Culture Office is finalizing 180 days of community building prompts and will continue to support sites in integrating these research-based practices into the school week.

Included in the communication is an infographic with the districts overall results as well as participation rates. Please note that disproportionality represents a particular student group's representation in a specific metric (suspension, AP enrolment, etc.) that differs from the representation of all other students not identified in that particular student group. Also included are district level reports for these survey questions by region by school for elementary and secondary.

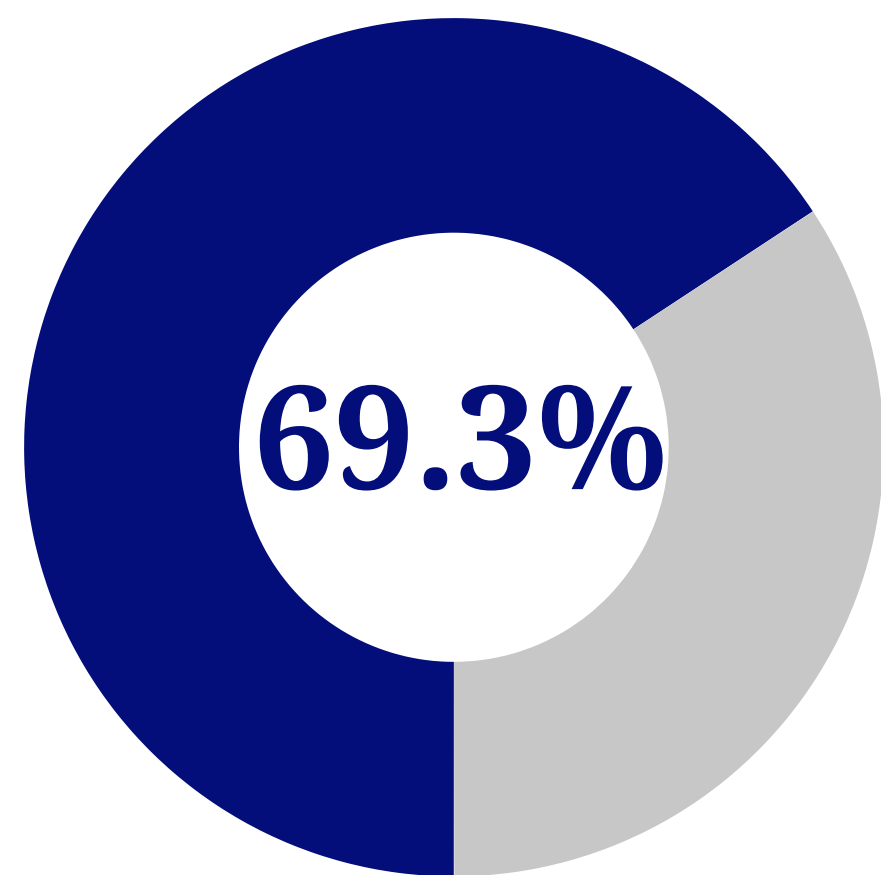

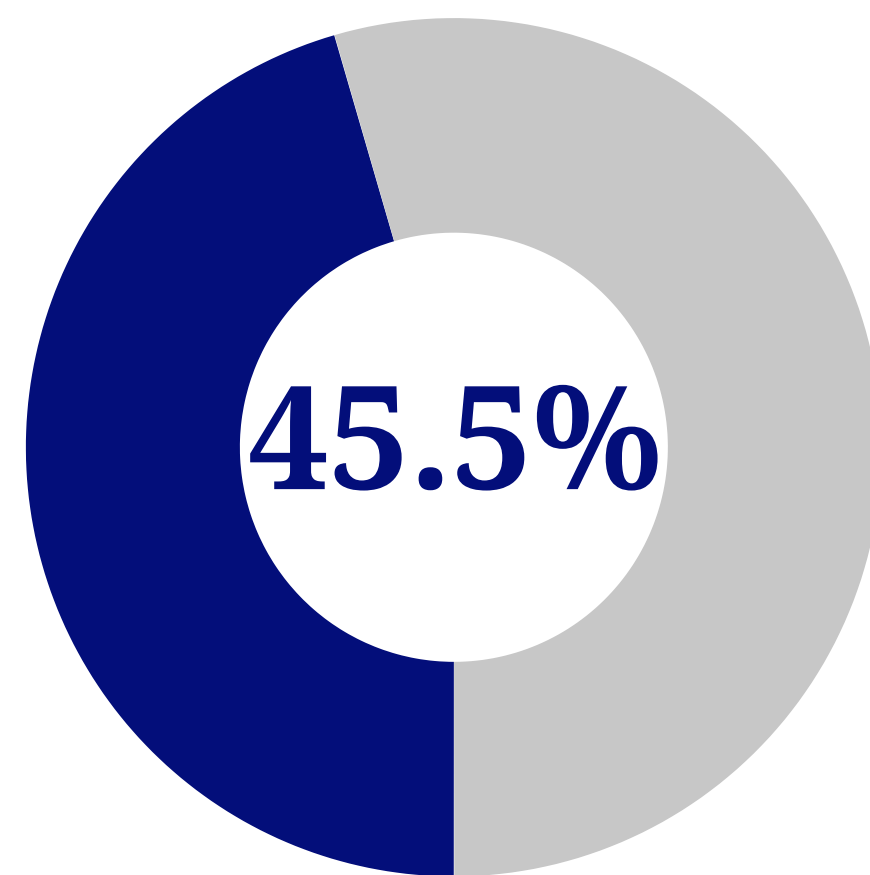

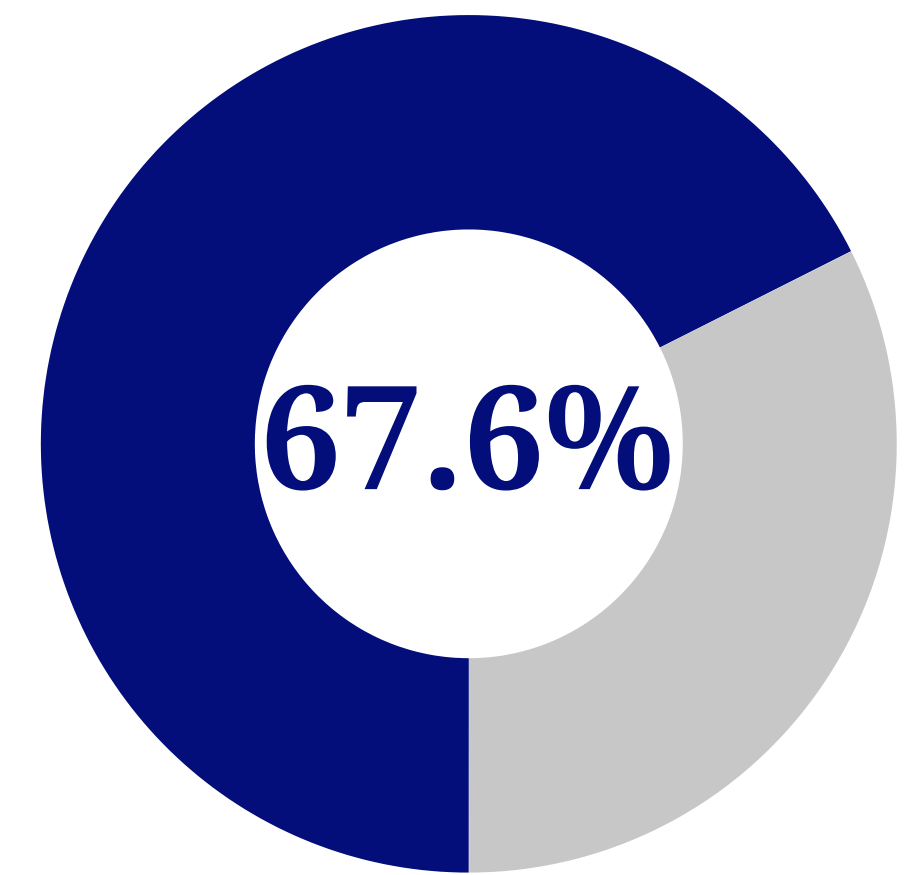

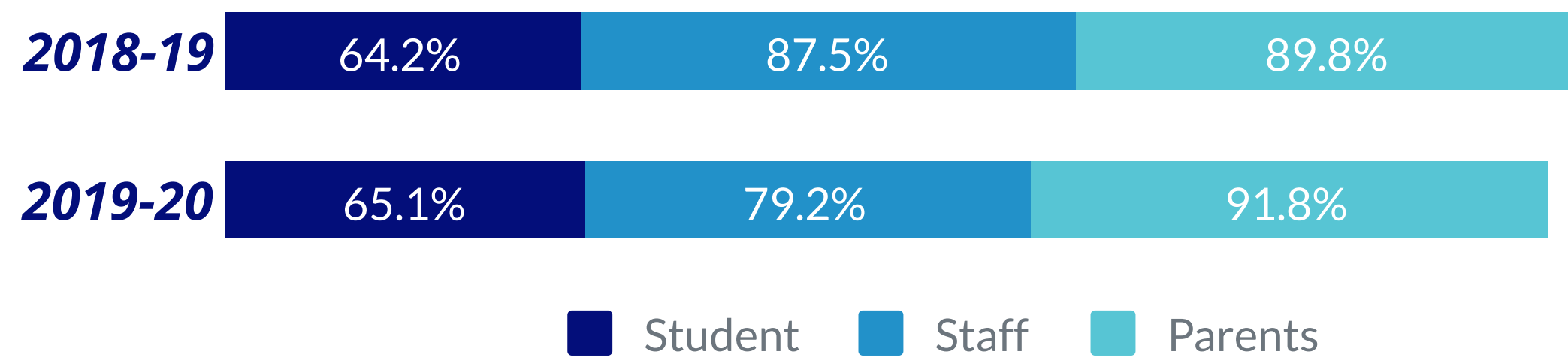

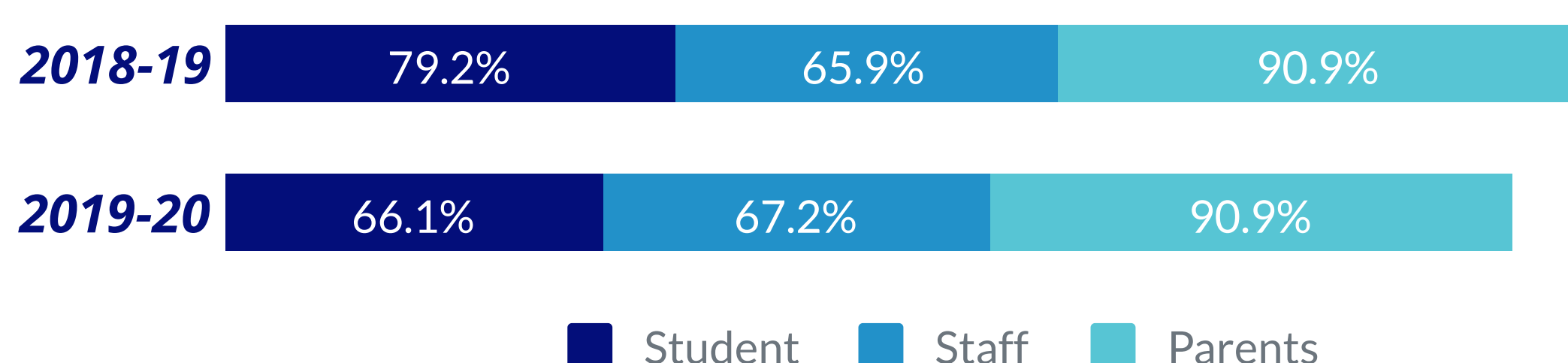
Affirmative Responses By Domain*

Climate of Support for Academic Learning



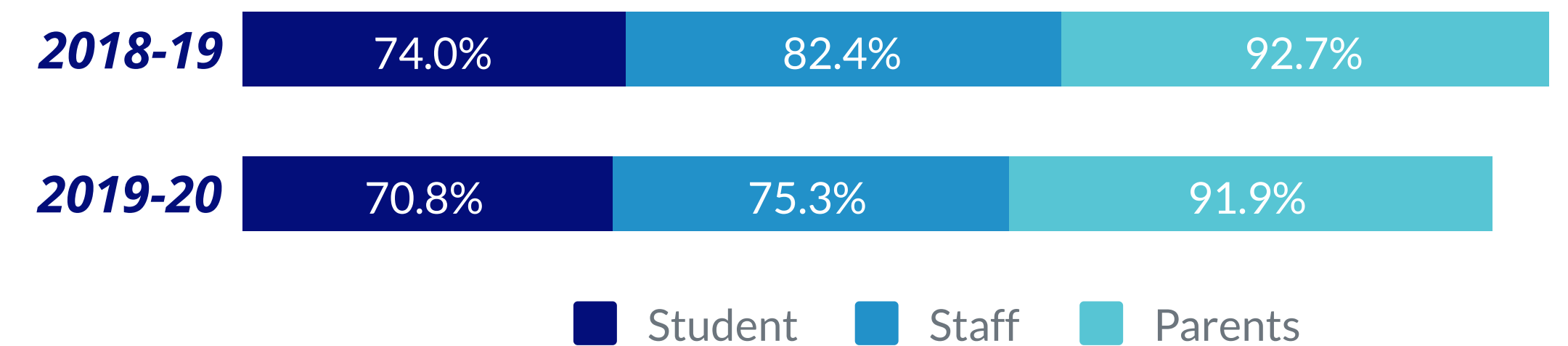

Sense of Safety



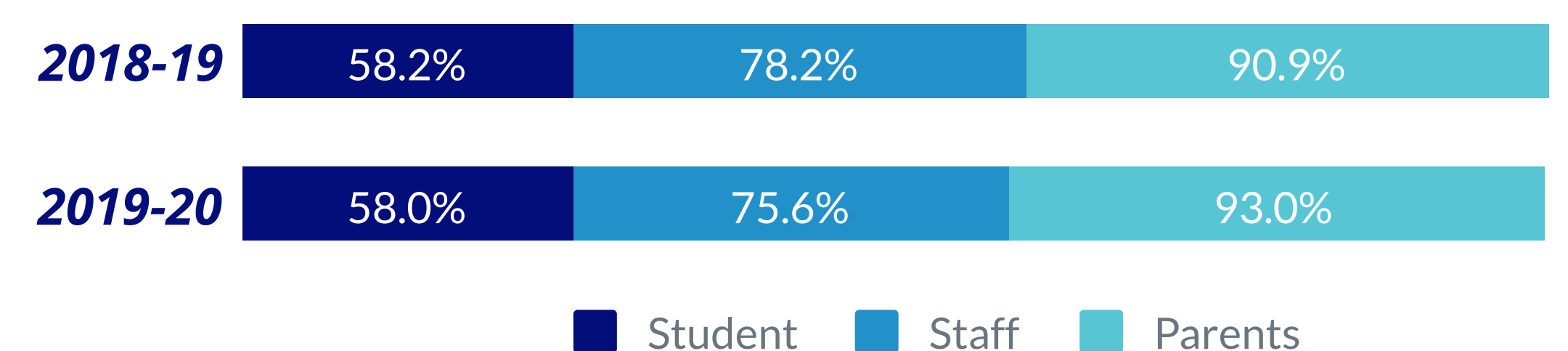

Regarding: Fresno Unified Spring Climate/Culture Survey Results

The purpose of this communication is to provide the Board requested information on the Climate/Culture (CC) survey results administered during Spring 2020/21. Students in grades 4 to 12 participate in the annual survey. 32,991 students completed the Climate/Culture student survey, 10,436 parents completed the Climate/Culture parent survey, and 4,483 staff completed the Climate/Culture staff survey. Fifty-five percent of students feel a sense of belonging and 54% of students report feeling connection to adults on campus. Ninety-two percent of parents report a sense of belonging while 87% of staff feel a sense of belonging.

To further address the climate/culture of our district, a collaborative team of Equity and Access, African American Academic Acceleration, Student Engagement Department, Communications, Prevention and Intervention, Special Education, and English Learner Services have continued to lead the Student Voice Collaborative across various departments and student groups. This collaborative has continued to involve students' in school-related issues and concerns toward improving the climate and culture of their school. The Student Voice Collaborative aims to ensure representation from various student groups, create alignment in efforts, and ensure all student groups have a voice and an opportunity to be heard.

Before the spring survey window, Climate and Culture Specialists reached out to site administration and Climate and Culture Teams to discuss the survey components, align to site/district goals, discuss best practices for survey administration, and craft communication plans encouraging students to share their voice via the survey. Every 2-3 days throughout the survey window, Climate and Culture Managers shared student requests for support with site administrators and identified support partners to assist students promptly. Following the survey, Climate and Culture Specialists supported site administrators and Climate and Culture Teams in analyzing survey results, planning, and implementing high leverage actions, and monitoring progress.

Also included in this communication is the district-level results from our 2020/21 spring Climate/Culture student, parent, and staff survey. Please note that the infographic includes comparisons between Fresno Unified's fall student Climate/Culture survey and the spring student Climate/Culture survey. As a reminder, the fall CC survey was only administered to students and included 10 questions focused on two areas: Adult connection and School Belonging. Also included are district level reports for these survey questions by region by school for elementary and secondary.

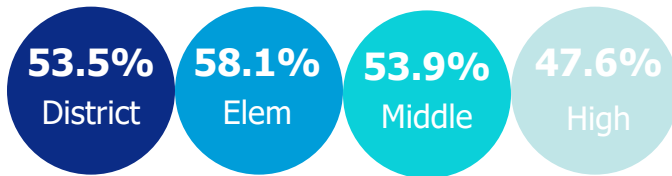
SPRING CLIMATE & CULTURE SURVEY PERFORMANCE

Total Student Voices in the Spring Climate & Culture Survey

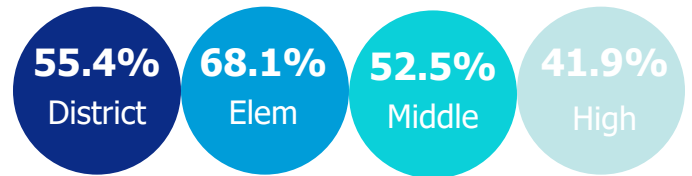

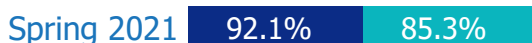

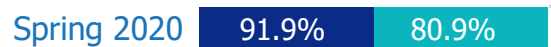

The purpose of this communication is to provide the Board information regarding climate and culture metrics for Fresno Unified during quarter 4.

The metrics included in this report are:

- Quarter 3 and Quarter 4/Semester 2 2020/21 chronic absenteeism rates, including disproportionality among student groups.
- Year to date 2019/20 and 2020/21 chronic absenteeism rates
- Quarter 3 and Quarter 4/Semester 2 suspension and expulsion rates, including disproportionality among student groups.
 - Please note: The size of the student group impacts the disproportionality rate. Small changes in student groups with small population sizes can result in large changes in disproportionality rates. For example, although only one homeless youth has been suspended, there is a 11.25% disproportionality rate due to the small number of homeless students enrolled in the district.
- Year to date 2019/20 and 2020/21 student misbehaviors, suspension rates, and expulsion rates.
 - Please note that students with no disproportionality calculation had no students suspended for Quarter 4 in the 2020/21 academic year. Also, there are currently no expulsions for Quarter 4 of the 2020/21 academic year, so disproportionality was unable to be calculated.
